Firstly we need to consider their furnishing needs. There are four identified areas below to come up with designs for toy storage, clothing storage, bed and desk/work area.

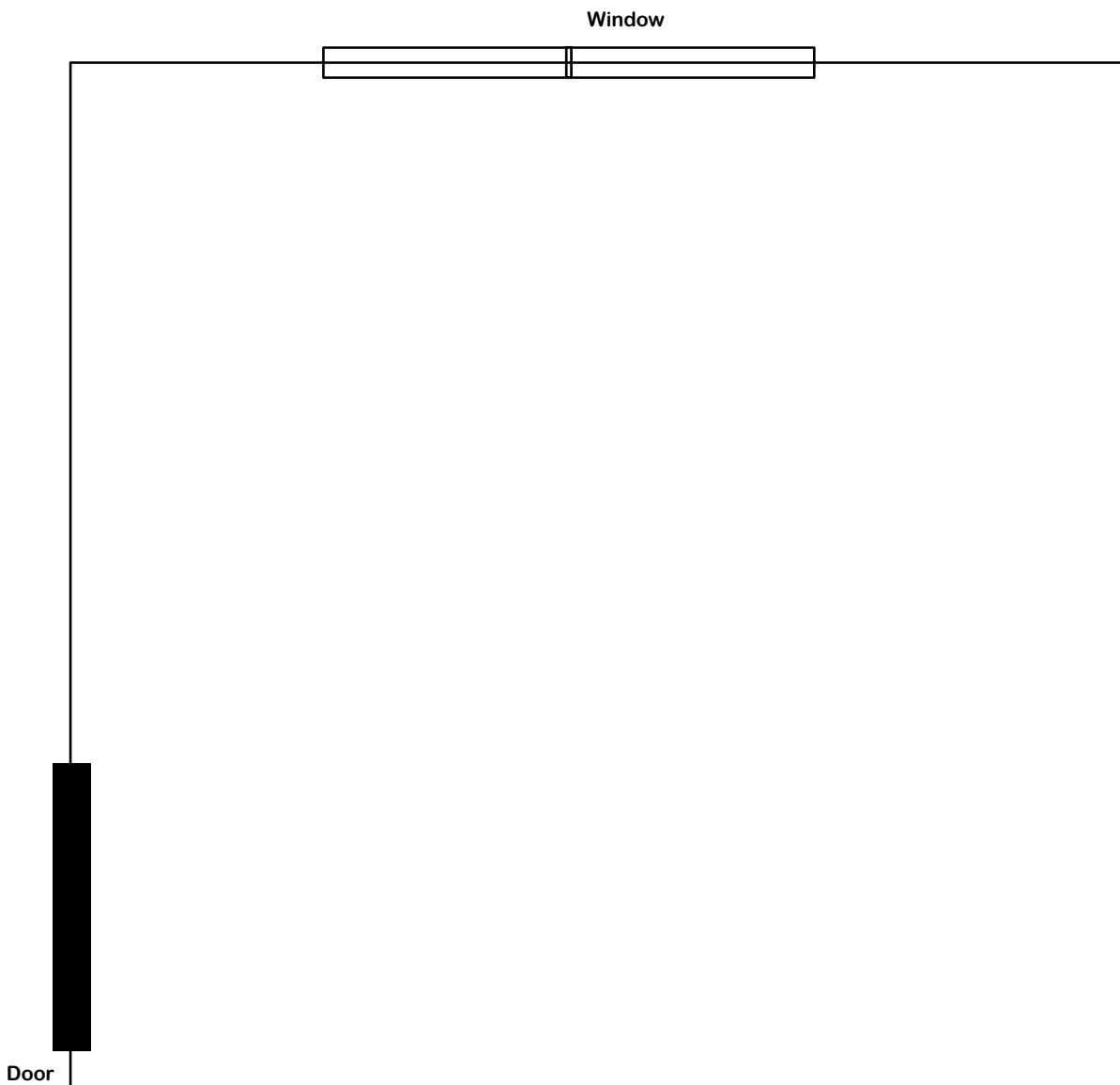
Toy storage	Clothing storage
