What would you ask him and what do you think his responses would be?</i></p>
<p>Draw out the stage for the night that the monster awakens. Think about the lighting, special effects and any props.</p>	<p>Create a front page newspaper article for one of the monster's killings. Include witness statements and quotes.</p>	<p>Using the play you have studied for inspiration, write a piece of creative gothic writing based on an idea or image or thought from the play.</p>
